It is very important that all parents/carers inform the school office as soon as possible if your child will not be attending school for any reason – remember to provide details about the reason for absence and not just “unwell or sick” as we will then have to call you back and ask for more clarification. As attendance is part of our safeguarding duties it is really important that we are kept informed of all absences. We thank you for your co-operation.

Covid 19 reminders

- If your child has any Covid symptoms (temperature, cold like symptoms, cough, loss of taste/smell) book a PCR test for them and ensure they stay at home until you receive their results.
- If someone in your household has tested positive for Covid, so long as your child is displaying no symptoms they can continue to come into school as normal.
- As an adult, if you have had contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid and you are not double vaccinated, you need to isolate for 10 days. If you are double vaccinated, you can continue as normal but should complete a lateral flow test for 7 days just like your child.
- Adults and secondary school pupils are encouraged to use a LFT test regularly to pick up any asymptomatic cases of Covid.
- We will be continuing to limit the number of parents and visitors into school. If you do need to come into the school building for any reason, please **wear a face mask** (unless you are exempt).
- All children should have extra layers on underneath their uniform due to the need for windows to be kept open so that the building is well ventilated. It is difficult to keep the school warm as the weather gets colder.

SEN SUPPORT SLOTS

As you may already know, I am the school's SENCO - this stands for special educational needs coordinator. This means that I oversee our provision for children who, for one reason or another, might be struggling with their learning. A special educational need means when someone needs help which is **additional to** or **different from** the support generally given to all children of the same age. Special educational needs can

occur for all sorts of reasons; they can crop up at any time. With the right support, we can help children overcome these needs and make good progress.

We work very hard to identify these needs early and come up with creative ways to help our children access their learning. One of the most important aspects of this is our work with families - you know your children better than anyone! If you are concerned about your child's learning, I am available to discuss how we can help your child. I am making every Monday afternoon between 1:30 and 4:00 free for parents and carers to book appointments to speak with me. This is open to all parents and carers, whether your child already is already receiving support or not. If you'd like to book a slot to talk with me then please email office@magdalengates.co.uk. SCHOOL UNIFORM AND PE KITS
